Background

REACH (Registration, **E**valuation and **A**uthorization of **Ch**emicals) entered into force on June 1, 2007. This letter presents Husqvarna Group's current position regarding the EU REACH regulation and addresses our obligations and our commitment to meet the legal obligations under EU REACH as well as UK REACH Regulation.

Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC)

Certain substances have been selected, listed and issued in the candidate list by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) as Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC). The REACH regulation thereby encourages manufacturers to substitute these chemicals, when suitable alternatives have been identified.

From 5 January 2021, companies are obliged to submit information on articles containing SVHC to ECHA via the SCIP database established under the Waste Framework Directive (WFD).

The Husqvarna Group maintains constant and on-going checks, in close cooperation with our suppliers, on the content in products and other articles to be able to give the latest information.

We will use our best efforts to provide updated and relevant information required for compliance with the EU REACH regulation and UK REACH regulation, hence Article 33 declarations, including corresponding SCIP reference, are managed and maintained for each product.
